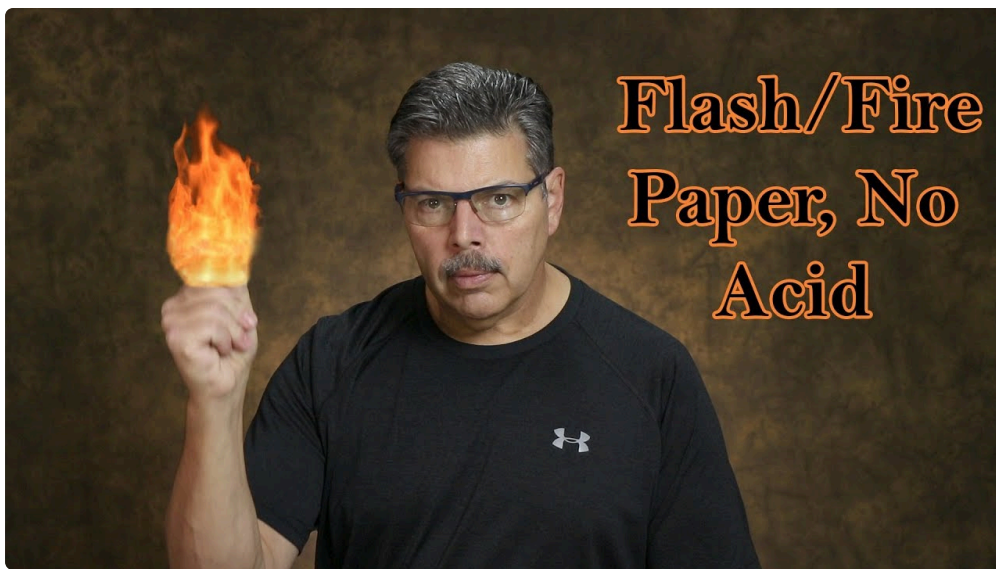
- 1) Show a strip of popular paper and convey it close your warm source for a practical moment, then prevent.
