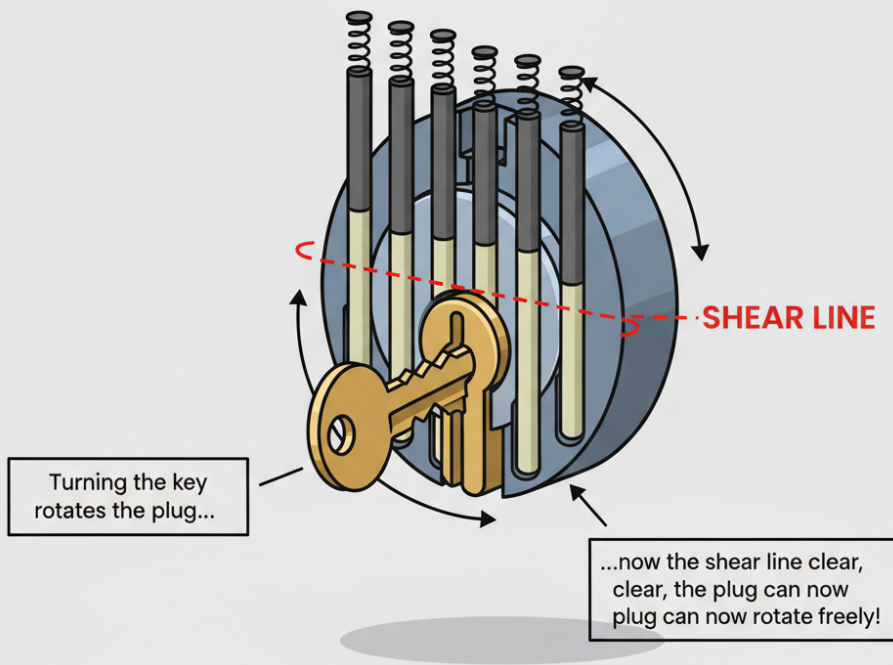

That matters because homeowners usually want a fix that is durable, not just one that looks good for a day or two. Why fast response matters for home security
