What is a CS2 Case?

A CS2 case is a virtual loot box that players can obtain while playing the video game on main Valve servers. To open a case, a player should utilize two things:

2. **A decryption Key**, which can be purchased in-game for a flat rate of £ 2.50 GBP (or local equivalent).

As soon as opened, the case spins through a randomized series before landing on a specific weapon surface. The item is then included directly to the player's Steam Inventory, where it can be kept, traded with other players, or offered on the Steam Community Market (SCM) or third-party markets.

How to Get CS2 Cases

Gamers normally acquire cases through 3 main approaches: active drops, the Steam Market, and third-party trading websites.

1. Weekly Drops

Valve benefits active gamers by giving case drops.

- **The Prime Status Advantage:** Only players with Prime Status (bought or made by means of reaching Level 21 in CS: GO) are qualified for weekly case drops.
- **The Drop Pool:** Players generally receive one weapon case and a couple of graffiti or weapon skin drops upon ranking up every week. This resets every Wednesday.

- **Active vs. Rare Pools:** Valve rotates cases. "Active Duty" cases drop frequently after matches, while older cases move to the "Rare/Discontinued Drop Pool," where they drop at an excruciatingly low rate (estimated around 1% per drop).

2. Steam Community Market

For particular cases that are no longer in the active drop pool, players turn to the Steam Community Market. Prices vary based on supply and demand.

3. Third-Party Trading Platforms

Numerous traders utilize respectable third-party websites to buy and sell cases using real-world fiat currency or cryptocurrencies, typically bypassing the Steam Wallet funds limitation.

CS2 Case Drop Pools

Understanding where a case sits in the drop hierarchy helps players decide whether to hold onto cases as investments or open them.

Drop Status	Description	Examples	Normal Price Range
Active Pool	Currently dropping to gamers at the end of matches. High supply, low rarity.	Kilowatt Case, Recoil Case, Gallery Case	£ 0.10-- £ 1.00
Rare Pool	No longer dropping routinely after matches. Low drop rate (~ 1%).	Clutch Case, Prisma Case, Danger Zone Case	£ 1.50-- £ 15.00

The Mathematics of Case Opening: What Are the Odds?

Before opening a CS2 case, every player needs to understand the mathematics behind the spin. Valve does not officially release exact percentages, however comprehensive community information mining and millions of taped openings have revealed consistent drop rates.

Item Rarity Tiers and Probabilities

When a case opens, it rolls for among the following wear tiers:

- **Mil-Spec (Blue):** ~ 79.92%
- **Restricted (Purple):** ~ 15.98%
- **Classified (Pink):** ~ 3.20%
- **Covert (Red):** ~ 0.64%
- **Special Item (Knives/ Gloves):** ~ 0.26%

Note: There is likewise approximately a 10% chance that any dropped weapon will feature a "StatTrak" module, which tracks the number of eliminates made with that specific weapon.

The Wear and Tear Factor (Float Values)

Even if a gamer strikes it rich and pulls an unusual knife or a Covert rifle, the product's condition-- called the **Float Value**-- dramatically impacts its worth. The wear categories are:

1. Factory New (FN)
2. Minimal Wear (MW)

3. Field-Tested (FT)
4. Well-Worn (WW)
5. Battle-Scarred (BS)
