1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sections on the wheel.
- **How it works:** A coin with a red side and a blue side is turned by a maker. Each side is appointed a random multiplier before the flip. Whichever color lands deal with up identifies the player's payout.
- **Re-flip feature:** If the multipliers appointed to the coin are exceptionally low, the host may trigger a "Rescue" re-flip to give players an opportunity at better worths.

2. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.
- **How it works:** This is a shooting gallery-style perk round. A huge screen shows 108 random multipliers hidden behind different carnival symbols (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat). Players use an on-screen crosshair to intend and shoot at one symbol before a countdown timer expires. Once the timer ends, all symbols expose their hidden multipliers.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 segment on the wheel.
- **How it works:** The ultimate perk round. The host opens a red door leading into a dynamic, surreal virtual world featuring a massive 64-segment wheel. Gamers should select among 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the picked flapper points to is granted. Like Pachinko, this wheel includes "Double" and "Triple" segments, which can push multipliers as much as an incredible 20,000 x.

Popular Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

Due To The Fact That Crazy Time [Bitz](#) is a video game of opportunity governed by RNG and physical probability, no technique can guarantee a profit. Nevertheless, gamers normally adopt various methods based upon their danger tolerance and bankroll management designs.

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:**

- *Focus:* Betting mainly on numbers 1 and 2, with periodic small cover bets on reward rounds.
- *Objective:* To lengthen gameplay and minimize quick bankroll depletion, depending on frequent little wins.

- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**

- *Focus:* Placing bets specifically on the four bonus rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time).
- *Goal:* To skip the lower-paying base game numbers completely and chase the massive multipliers found just in the bonus features. This needs a larger bankroll to sustain dry spells between bonus offer hits.
