2. Fiber and fat for stamina across a full season

Crude fiber measures 16.4% and crude fat 9.0%, including linseed oil — the slow-release energy sources distance programs rely on. Conditioning miles build the base; this feed is designed to support it. Crude protein at 15.1% helps maintain the muscle that the work develops.

Who this is for: horses on long conditioning programs between events.

3. Amino acids support the muscle cross-country demands

Lysine 1.0%, threonine 1.0%, and methionine plus cysteine at 0.93% — added essential amino acids that help support muscle function and aid recovery. A hard gallop course is the toughest test of muscle a horse faces. The formula is built to support that work.

The benefit: a full amino acid profile formulated for recovery after big gallops.

4. Competition-safe, FEI-compliant, and fit for scrutiny

5. Gut support for horses that live in the trailer

Diamond V inactivated yeast at 0.7% — a postbiotic from multi-stage fermentation — plus fructooligosaccharides are included to help maintain digestive comfort. Event horses are on the road constantly and eat in strange stables. That is precisely the lifestyle this gut package addresses.

Who this is for: competition horses that haul often and stable away from home.

How to feed it

Rates are given per 220 lb (100 kg) of body weight per day:

Work levelFeed per 220 lb (100 kg) body weight per day
Light work0.55 lb (250 g)
Medium work0.88 lb (400 g)
Heavy work1.32 lb (600 g)

Hay ration: 3.31 lb (1.5 kg) per 220 lb body weight daily, always alongside the feed.

Key specs at a glance: starch 15%, sugar 4.6%, crude protein 15.1%, crude fat 9.0%, digestible energy 12.6 MJ/kg DM, competition-safe and FEI-compliant.
