- **The Dual-Bet Strategy:**

- *How it works:* Players place 2 bets all at once. The first bet is set to auto-cash out at a moderate multiplier (e.g., 2.00 x) to secure a profit or break even. The second bet is delegated run by hand for a higher, riskier multiplier (e.g., 10x or greater).
