

Melbourne runs fast at night. Trams hum along Swanston Street, bikes string down Lygon, and food cyclists slalom previous lines outside late cooking areas. Covered right into that mix rests a particular niche logistics trouble that looks easy up until you build it at scale: obtaining cooking gas cylinders to a door, quickly and dependably, without reducing edges. Two kilometres in Melbourne can behave like 10 somewhere else. The grid and tram top priority make cross community relocations predictable in some corridors and frustrating in others.
