An place of work tower desired polished stainless dimensional letters on a pitcher curtain wall. Under bright solar, the reflections broke the notice into shards. We additional a narrow, non-reflective charcoal backer panel in the

back of the letters, set two inches off the glass. The letters still felt top class, however now the eye had a regular luminance container. Tenants stopped giving guidance that protected "one could pass over us the first time."

A save insisted on crimson letters over a mid-tone green fascia to fit a vacation campaign. Red on green compresses distinction for a lot of viewers. We awarded two mockups at scale, one with purple face lit letters over a deeper green panel, and one with white letters and a pink accent bar. The group selected the white letters. Seasonal accents lived on customized banners and window vinyl, at the same time as the storefront signals kept their all-season legibility. The numbers supported the decision.
