

When an air conditioner fails in the middle of a humid Elgin summer, the problem stops feeling minor very quickly. Rooms trap heat, sleep gets lighter, and a home that felt comfortable the day before starts to feel sticky by late afternoon. For families with small children, older adults, pets, or anyone working from home, a broken system can turn into an urgent repair call within hours.
