- Evaluate for lead and asbestos. On properties constructed earlier than 1978, verify chipping paint beforehand dry sanding. Popcorn textures mounted before the mid Eighties can include asbestos. Nicotine and smoke desire competitive sealing. On a old bungalow we taken care of, a ceiling that regarded beige bled yellow even after two coats of ceiling paint. We washed it, then carried out a full shellac most appropriate and two end coats. Skipping the shellac would have assured persistent bleed-because of. The room went from amber to crisp white, and the property owners stopped noticing a stale scent trapped above the crown.
