A chain-drive opener uses a metal chain and is usually durable, though it can be louder. A belt-drive opener uses a reinforced belt and is often less noisy, making it useful for attached garages located near bedrooms or living

spaces. Both systems require proper adjustment and safety testing.

Safety sensors near the floor must be aligned with each other and remain free of obstacles. If the indicator lights are off or blinking, the opener may fail to close the door. A garage door remote can also become unprogrammed or fail because of internal damage. Do not disable the safety sensors; they are designed to cause the door to reverse the door if a person, pet, or object is in the opening.

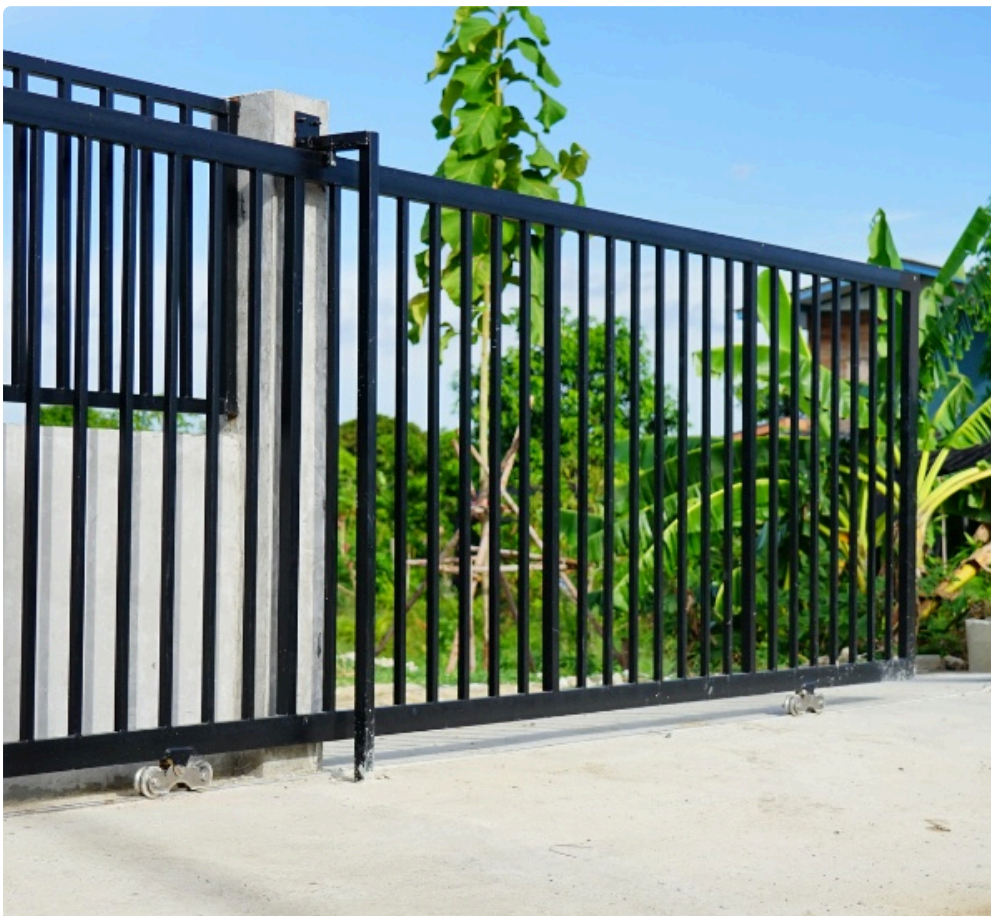
Garage-door Safety Tips for South Bay Homeowners

Keep photo-eye sensors free of dirt and aligned. Verify the reversal function according to the manufacturer's instructions, and never stand beneath a moving door. Keep tools, bicycles, toys, and storage containers away from the door's travel path. Do not attempt torsion spring repair, cable replacement, or track removal without proper instruction. If a door has come down, is hanging from one side, or has a broken spring, keep people and vehicles away until a professional gets there.

Regular garage door maintenance can include oiling approved moving parts, visual checks for rust and fraying, tightening accessible hardware, and testing the opener's safety functions. Avoid applying lubricant to photo-eye lenses or using products that draw in grime to the tracks.
