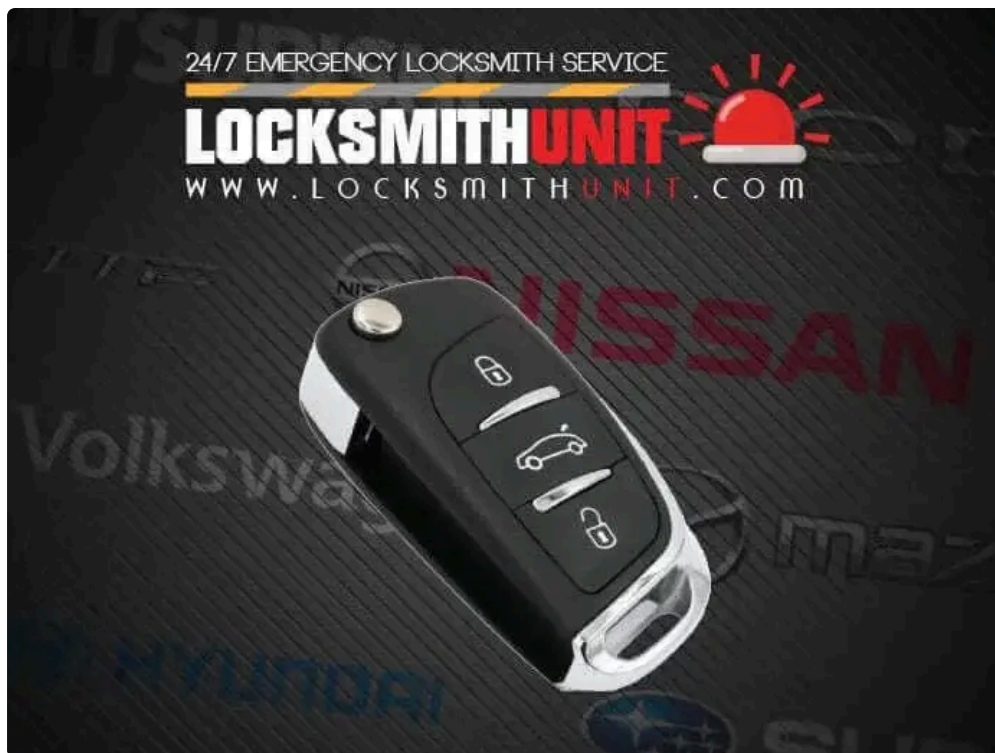
Why licensing and trust still matter
