Maybe you host movie nights and need an area for a soundbar, a small amp, and a basket of blankets. Anchoring your design to the ones routines helps to keep the shelving life like.

I wish to map the room in two passes. First, a birds-eye sketch with measured walls, windows, radiators, stores, vents, and the swing of any doorways. - Photograph each wall and mark the pix with measurements for reference.

In a slim rowhouse, we wrapped a window with bookshelves and equipped a 17 inch deep window seat over a shallow radiator cowl.
