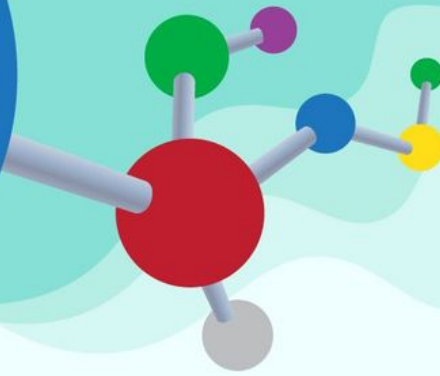


WHAT ARE PEPTIDES?
