Edge profiles, thickness, and the way they have interaction with pattern

A deep ogee draws the eye with shadow and curve. On a closely veined slab, the brink competes with the surface. Thickness affects presence. A three-centimeter precise with an eased polished edge is the default in lots of markets.
