

Head On Collision Lawyer Midland Texas On a two-lane stretch of Rankin Highway south of town, one bad decision to pass can put two vehicles nose to nose at highway speed. Head-on collisions are among the most violent crashes on Permian Basin roads, and the injuries tend to be severe: broken bones, head trauma, spinal damage and long stays at Midland Memorial Hospital. When it happens to you or someone you love, the questions start early. Who pays, how much, and what happens if the other driver's insurer says it was your fault? Most head-on crashes around Midland trace back to a handful of causes. Unsafe passing on two-lane roads like SH 349, SH 158 and the Lamesa Highway is a big one, especially when a driver gets impatient stuck behind a slow truck. Fatigue is another. Oilfield crews often work long shifts and drive home tired, and a driver who nods off can drift across the center line without ever touching the brakes. Flat, straight roads invite speeding, spring dust storms can cut visibility to almost nothing, and unlit [Midland Car Accident Lawyer](#) rural roads at night leave very little room for error. These cases often involve commercial vehicles, and that changes the investigation. A water hauler or frac sand truck may be owned by one company, driven by a contractor and covered by more than one insurance policy. Driver logs, dispatch records, maintenance files and electronic vehicle data can show whether fatigue or schedule pressure played a role. That kind of evidence can disappear if nobody asks for it quickly. The same is true for company pickups heading out SH 191 toward Odessa before sunrise, when crews are already hours into a long day. If you were hurt, missed work or the other driver's insurer is disputing fault, a lawyer usually pays for themselves. Texas gives you two years from the crash to file most injury lawsuits, but waiting that long is risky. What is the hardest injury to prove after a car accident?
