Energy Efficiency Practices for Multi-Day Events

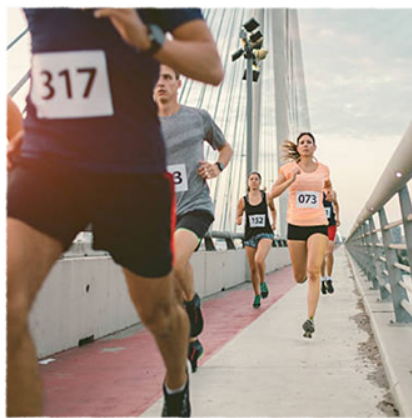
