How OpenAI Runs ChatGPT Plus Trials: Not Your Typical One-Month Trial

- **Trials Are Targeted Campaigns or Invitations.** You might receive an invite or be eligible for a trial based on your usage history, region, or marketing campaigns. These are not universally available on the website.
- **Trial Length Varies by Offer.** Some offers might give you a few days' worth of Plus access; others could last longer. There's no fixed "one-month free trial" period for ChatGPT Plus.
- **Credit Card Requirements Depend on the Offer.** Some trials require payment information upfront and will auto-renew after the trial, charging the \$20/month Plus fee unless you cancel before renewal.
- **Cancellation Before Renewal Is Key.** If you don't want to continue with the paid plan after the trial ends, you must cancel before it auto-renews to avoid being billed.

Bottom line: don't assume you're automatically signed up for a free month—check your email and subscription details carefully.

How to Check Your Confirmation Email for Trial Details

- **Payment Method Info (if any card is attached)**

Ignore this email at your own risk. It's easy to miss the renewal clause and get billed unexpectedly a few days or weeks later.

If you can't find your confirmation email, search for sender addresses like @openai.com or subject lines including "ChatGPT Plus," "Your subscription," or "Trial activation."

What to do next: Bookmark or archive your confirmation email so it's easy to revisit when checking your trial status.

Check Your Subscription End Date in Settings - Subscription

OpenAI provides control and transparency through your account dashboard. To verify your trial or subscription status, follow these steps:

1. Log into your ChatGPT account on the **web**.
2. Go to **Settings - Subscription**.
3. Review the subscription status, trial end date, and next billing date.
4. If you see a payment method attached, be aware that charges can occur automatically unless canceled.

Knowing exactly when your trial ends or your next payment is due helps prevent unwelcome surprises.

Warning: If a credit card was attached when signing up, your card will be charged \$20 (plus tax if applicable) automatically on the renewal date unless you cancel in time.

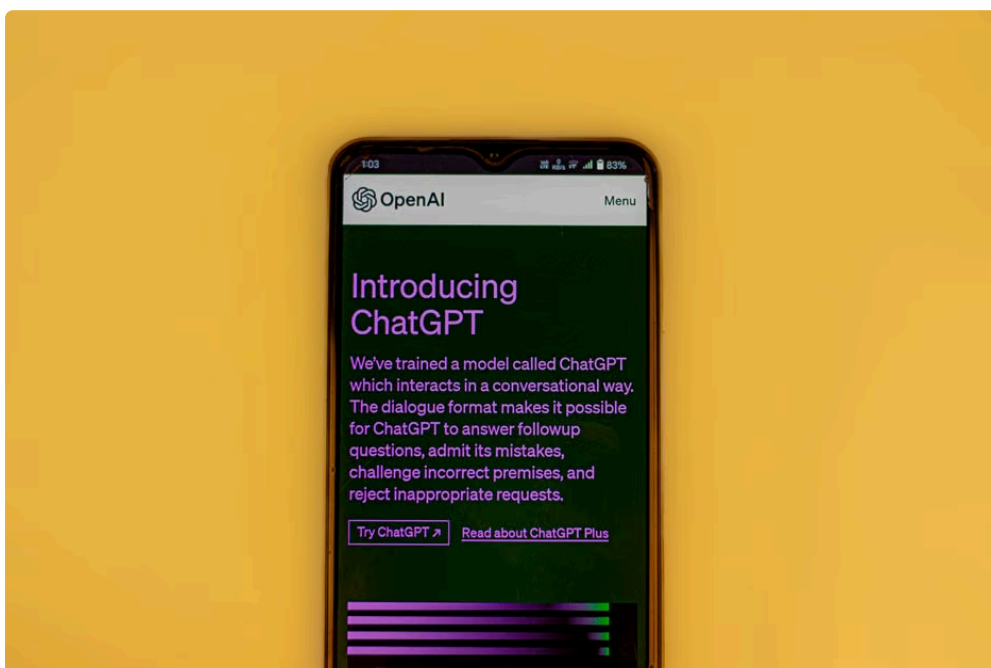
What to do next: Review your cancellation confirmation email and keep it for your records.
