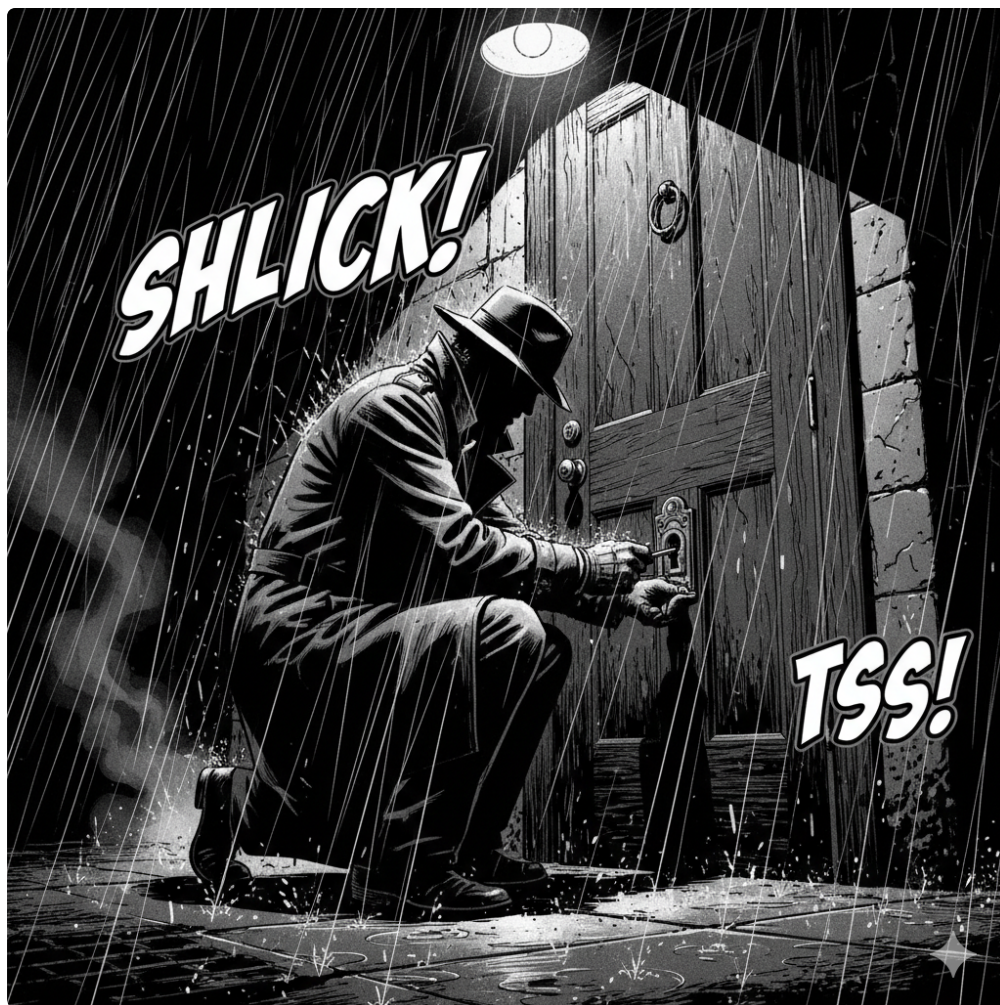
The trade-offs that actually matter
