2. The Martingale Strategy (Progression Betting)

- **The Strategy:** Double your bet each time you lose, and return to your base bet when you win.
- **The Goal:** Recover all previous losses with a single win plus a revenue equivalent to the base bet.
- **The Risk:** This requires a huge bankroll and can rapidly hit platform optimum bet limits or diminish your funds throughout an extended losing streak.

3. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)

- **The Strategy:** Double your bet after every *win*, and go back to the base bet after a loss.
- **The Goal:** Ride a hot streak to optimize earnings while decreasing risk throughout cold streaks.
- **The Risk:** You should manually squander at a reasonable multiplier (like 2.00 x) regularly for this to work.
