Because many Sherman Oaks homes have attached garages, maintain functional carbon monoxide detectors inside the home and near sleeping areas as recommended by local safety guidance. Never run a vehicle, generator, or fuel-burning equipment in an attached garage, even with the door open. Exhaust can reach living spaces quickly.
