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If you own a home in Arlington, you currently understand what our climate does to exterior surface areas. One wet spring and a shaded side of your house can begin growing algae. A number of seasons of pollen and traffic dust will turn a brilliant driveway dull gray. Brick steps get slick. Composite decks collect mildew in the grain.
