- Fasteners and decking: Six nail sample for architectural shingles, nails lengthy adequate to penetrate the sheathing by means of not less than three/four inch. Replace any spongy OSB. If a roof from the Nineties has thin 3/eight inch sheathing, plan to resheath or add nailing guide at minimum, particularly over cathedral ceilings.

The attic dropped roughly 10 levels on summer season afternoons, and the kin stopped operating box fans within the upstairs hallway.

A ranch in Point of Woods had an ice dam that leaked by way of a toilet vent stack, staining the ceiling just before New Year's. The eave lacked ice and water protect, and the metal flange had been face sealed with caulk. We additional two guides of ice and water, put in a neoprene flashing boot, and increased the exhaust pipe to satisfy code height. That roof rode out the following winter without a mark.
