MACULE Flat lesion less than 1 cm		
PATCH Flat lesion, more than 1 cm		
PAPULE Raised lesion, less than 1 cm		
PLAQUE Raised lesion, more than 1 cm		
PUSTULE Pus filled lesion, usually less than 1 cm		
VESICLE Fluid filled lesion, less than 0.5 cm		
BULLA Fluid filled lesion, more than 0.5 cm		
NODULE Firm lesion, more than 1 cm		
TUMOR Firm lesion, more than 2 cm		
CYST Cavity filled with air, fluid or semisolid material		
WHEAL Superficial raised lesion		
BLOOD SPOTS Bleeding into the skin		

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Sometimes, the carrier may be able to prevent bleeding completely by freezing the tags off. While the existence of skin tags can be unsightly and aggravating, there aren't lots of factors to remove them. If they are in locations where they can obtain stuck in clothing or zippers, it may be an excellent idea to have them removed to prevent discomfort and bleeding. Both excrescences and moles have a broad base and go deep right into the skin, yet on a mole, the skin remains soft. Verrucas, however, appear as rough skin, possibly with points on the surface. They frequently appear on the hands, feet, joints, and knees-- where the skin is thicker and expands more gradually.
