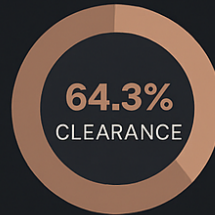


Safe Removal Options



CRYOTHERAPY

Freezes skin tags using liquid nitrogen.



SURGICAL EXCISION

Cuts off larger tags at the base with surgical scissors and local anaesthetic.



ELECTROCAUTERY

Uses electric current to burn off skin tags and seal blood vessels.



LIGATION

Ties off blood supply to the skin tag using surgical thread.



An adhesive patch in a study also removed 177 skin tags within 3-6 days.
