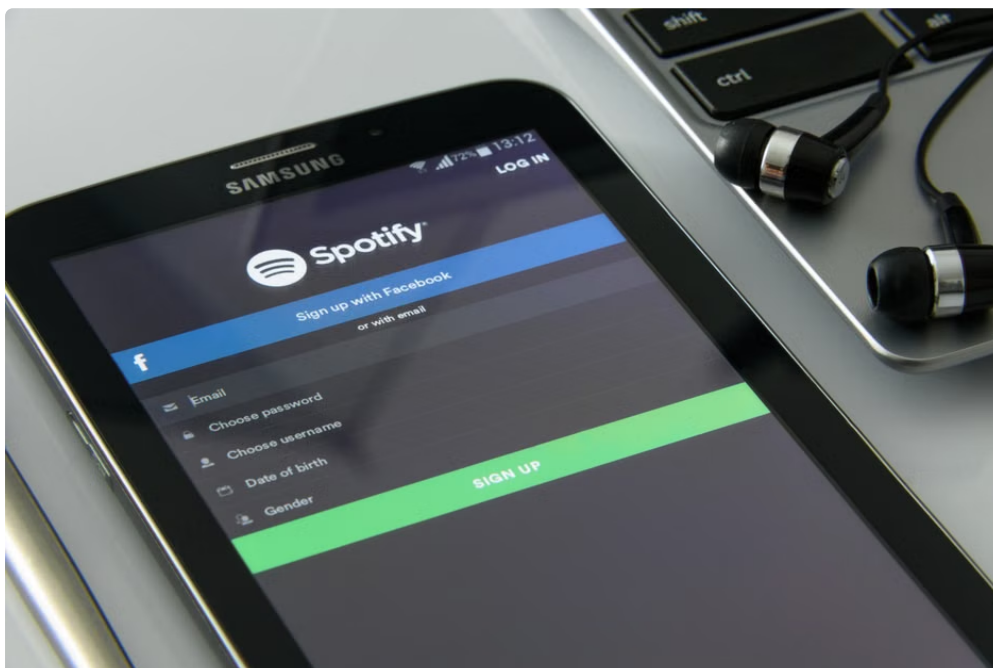

App download pages	Pages to download the BingoPlus app or other resources, not for logging in. Download apps if you want, but always go back to the login screen to sign in—it's not the same as verification.	

The key takeaway? App download pages and guidance FAQs are not places to complete your verification step. Only the authentication or login screen supports that process.

Separating Account Recovery from Navigation and Verification

It's tempting to think of account recovery (like "forgot password") as a fix for every login issue, but it's a distinct process. If your verification step isn't completing, account recovery won't necessarily solve it unless you can't remember your password or login details.



Account recovery is usually a separate link or flow from the login screen. Verify that you're:
