Why mobile locksmith service matters for local drivers

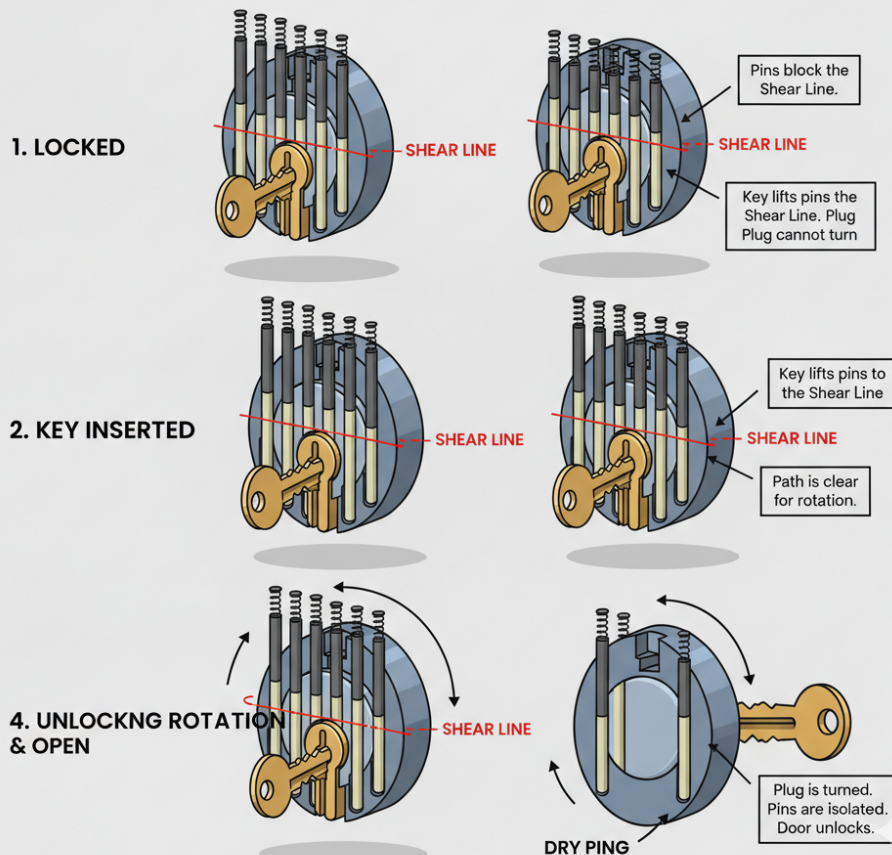
