

Poway has a way of surprising people. From the freeway, it can look like just another inland San Diego suburb, but spend a full day here and the place starts to show its character. There is a strong local identity, the kind built around open space, equestrian trails, community parks, and neighborhoods that still feel lived in rather than staged for visitors. The weather plays a big role in that experience. Poway sits inland enough to feel the heat more sharply than the coast, and that simple fact shapes everything from when people plan a hike to how seriously homeowners think about Air Conditioning.
