Damaged Springs, Cables, Rollers, and Hinges

A broken garage door spring is one of the frequent reasons for a service call. A torsion spring is mounted above the door and uses stored energy to counterbalance its weight. An extension spring stretches along the sides of some garage doors. Both types can wear out, particularly when exposed to moisture, corrosion, and constant daily cycles.

Signs of spring trouble include a door that will not lift, a visible gap in the spring, loud snapping sounds, or a door that feels too heavy when operated manually.
