House lockouts and rekey work tend to happen together

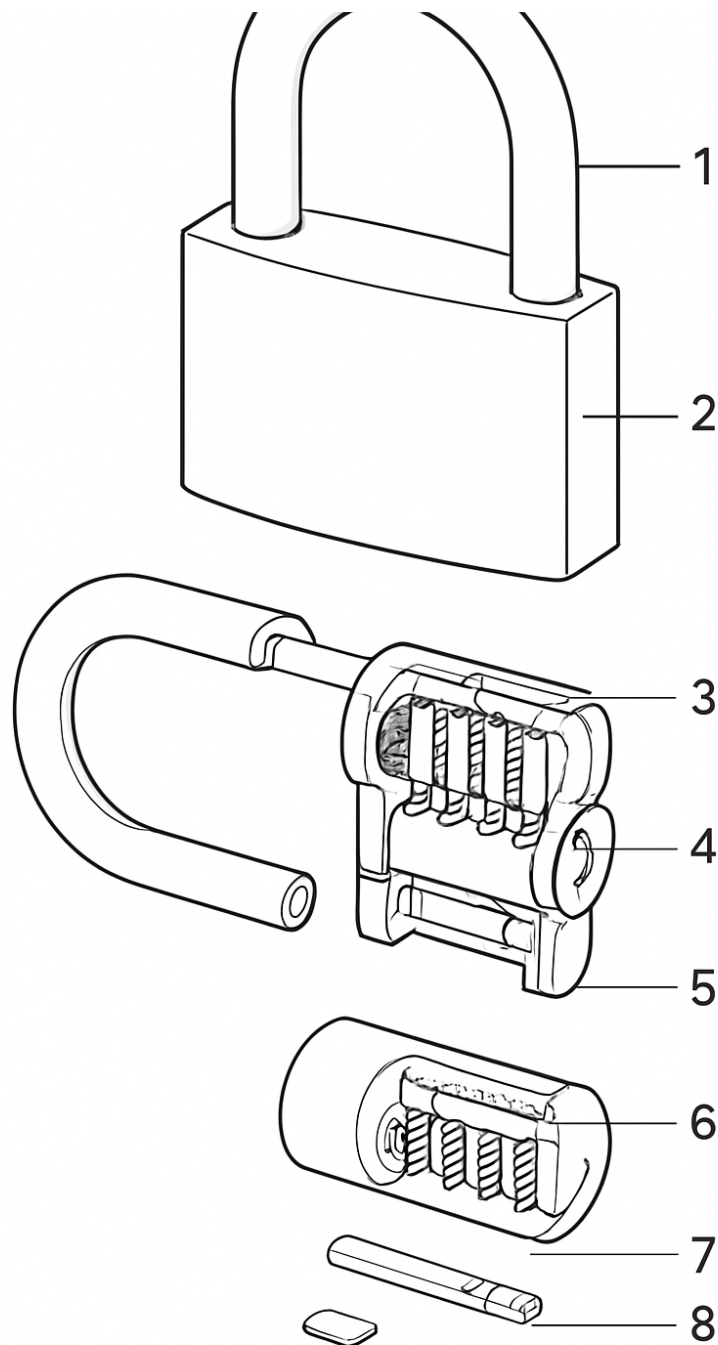
