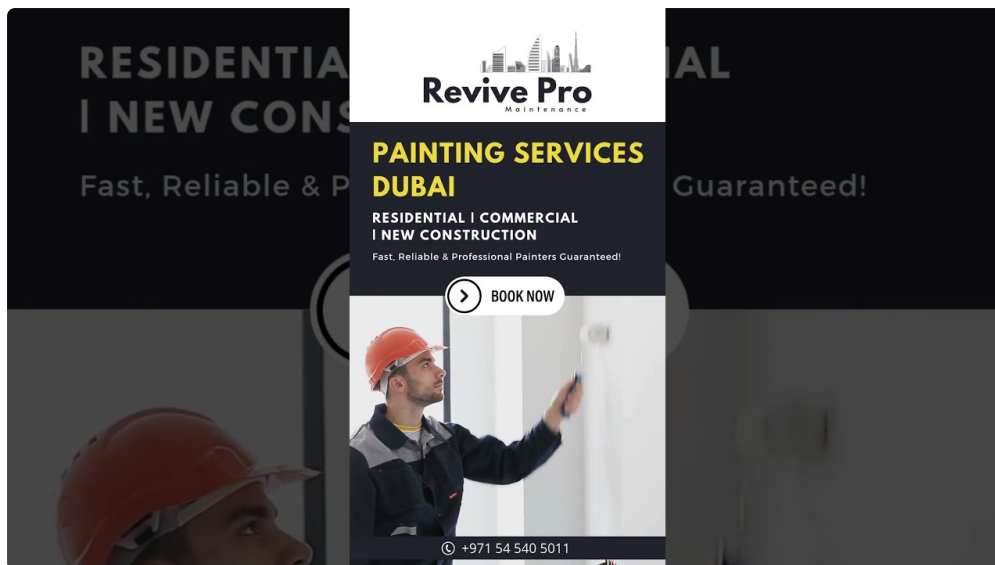

The room went from amber to crisp white, and the house owners stopped noticing a stale smell trapped above the crown.
