CSGO wagering sites profited from this by providing custom case openings with adjusted chances. *Case Battles* take this a step even more, permitting multiple gamers to open the very same cases concurrently, with the gamer who unboxes the greatest overall value winning all the contents.

4. Coinflip

A traditional 1v1 video game of opportunity. 2 gamers wager skins of approximately equivalent value. The system designates one gamer as Heads and the other as Tails, then turns a virtual coin. The [click here](#) winner takes the entire pot, minus a small platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the expert scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match betting is the go-to alternative. Users wager [CS2 Casino](#) on professional groups utilizing odds calculated by the platform, similar to conventional sportsbooks.
