What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live casino game developed around a giant, vertical 52-segment wheel. The game is hosted by a live, energetic speaker who spins the wheel, interacts with the audience through live chat, and guides players through the different sections.

What sets Crazy Time apart from basic wheel video games (like *Dream Catcher*) is the addition of a top slot positioned straight above the primary wheel. With every spin, the leading slot spins at the same time, producing a random multiplier for a particular bet spot. If the wheel stops on that area and a reward or number is multiplied, players can win astronomical payouts.

Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52 segments on the Crazy Time wheel are divided into numbers (which pay out standard prize money) and benefit rounds (which activate minigames). Comprehending the distribution of these sectors is important for handling bankrolls and comprehending the game's volatility.

The Number Bets

Gamers can place bets on four various numbers: **1, 2, 5, and 10**. Each number corresponds to its payment multiplier if the wheel arrive on it.

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel (highest frequency, least expensive payout of 1:1).
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel (payout of 2:1).
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel (payment of 5:1).

- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel (payment of 10:1).

The Bonus Rounds

The true enjoyment of Crazy Time depends on its 4 bonus rounds. These occupy a combined overall of 9 segments on the wheel, making them rarer to strike, but significantly more satisfying.

1. **Coin Flip** (4 segments on the wheel)
2. **Pachinko** (2 sections on the wheel)
3. **Cash Hunt** (2 sections on the wheel)
4. **Crazy Time** (1 segment on the wheel)

The Four Thrilling Bonus Rounds Explained

When the wheel stops on a perk segment, all gamers who placed a bet on that specific bonus round are transferred to a separate, immersive set (or augmented reality screen) to take part.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the bonus rounds, Coin Flip involves a coin with a Red side and a Blue side. Each side is assigned a random multiplier by the game system before the flip. The host pulls a lever to turn the coin, and whichever side lands face up awards the gamer that corresponding multiplier. If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can in some cases be set off for a 2nd possibility.

2. Pachinko

Motivated by the standard Japanese arcade game, the Pachinko benefit round includes a massive wall filled with physical pegs. The game host drops a puck from the top of the board, and it bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs till it lands in one of the multiplier zones at the bottom.

- If the puck arrive on a "**Double**" worth, all multipliers at the bottom of the wall double, and the puck is dropped again for even higher stakes.

3. Cash Hunt

Money Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery minigame. Gamers are presented with a huge screen [play crazy time free](#) showing 108 random multipliers hidden behind various symbols (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).

- Players use an on-screen crosshair to goal and "shoot" their picked sign before the timer runs out.
- As soon as time ends, all symbols reveal their covert multipliers, and players receive the multiplier connected to their selected target.

4. Crazy Time

The crown gem of the game is the Crazy Time reward round. Players walk through a red door into a lively, virtual wonderland featuring a huge, 64-segment mega wheel.

- Before the wheel is spun, players should choose among 3 flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the selected flapper indicate is granted to the player.

- Similar to Pachinko, this wheel includes **"Double"** and **"Triple"** sections. If the flapper arrive on one of these, the multipliers on the wheel boost, and the wheel is spun once again-- possibly pushing payments up to the game's maximum limit of **20,000 x**.

Key Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is fundamentally a game of opportunity powered by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and a physical wheel, players frequently embrace particular betting methods to handle their danger and extend their playtime.



Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe & Steady Strategy (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mainly on wagering on numbers 1 and 2, while putting little hedge bets on perk rounds. This technique yields regular, smaller sized wins and keeps the bankroll steady.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - Place bets solely on the four benefit rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-volatility method created for players who wish to experience the minigames as often as possible, accepting that they may experience dry spells of non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
 - Cover a mix of numbers and all 4 bonus rounds proportionally. This guarantees that nearly every spin of the wheel yields some type of return or sets off a function.

Essential Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed bankroll before visiting and never chase losses.
- **Understand RTP:** Keep in mind that various bets have a little various Return to Player portions. Number bets generally use a higher analytical RTP than benefit bets, however perk bets offer the excitement of enormous multipliers.
