Cardboard bales accounted for 2 vans worth of amount we did now not should haul, which cut disposal rates by using round 20 p.c. E-waste went to a qualified recycler with a serialized checklist, and we added photograph packets to the district manager prior to 7 a.m. Final walk-throughs with the landlord went smoothly. The biggest time saver was a supervisor who staged broken merchandise and called out two furnishings that had been transferring to a close-by position so we did not by chance haul them.

Aftercare: finishing clean and ultimate the loop
