We lower back-brushed two coats of a satin acrylic at the physique and used a moderately shrink sheen at the crown tips to preserve glare down under the afternoon sunlight.

The property owner instructed me later that the appropriate payment spent was now not the paint logo but the time budgeted for caulking and notice-priming at elevation.
